



Christmas Party Entertainment Package

The secret to making the High 5 It - Christmas Party work is accomplished by the supplied scorecards and game instructions that were designed with years of experience with first hand facilitation of such events. After setting up the games and splitting the group into teams the organizer basically just has to say go and at the end announce the winners if they so choose.

The package contains some of our most popular games that get people out of their chairs interacting and having a blast. Our extras such as Santa hats, elf hats and plush reindeer antlers, to be worn by all, will add to the Christmas atmosphere. For those who are reluctant to participate we include some Bah Humbug! hats. This usually brings a smile to their face and actually gets them involved as deep down they really do like Christmas and want to be a part of all the fun and excitement. Each table or team receives a team mascot that they can name and bring to all the events. These mascots are so likeable that you better keep a close eye on them as opposing teams might kidnap them and do who knows what.

The name of the game is "Save the Reindeer" and to the horror of everyone all of Santa's reindeer have been nabbed by an Elf gone bad. Either the organizer or a helper wearing the Elf costume that is supplied can portray the "bad Elf". The goal of each team is to free the most reindeer. This is accomplished by how well they do in each of the 4 events. After each round of events, the bad elf or helpers will hand out the appropriate amount of reindeer, which are included in this package, to each team. The team with the most "freed" reindeer at the end wins. How much the organizers play all this up is up to them. The event will go very well if all they do is wear the hats keep score and hand out reindeer. To help the event run smoothly and basically on it's own, team scorecards are provided that direct teams where to go and which opponent they will meet. Included is a master score sheet for each group of eight teams and an easy 5 step set of instructions that will guide the organizer problem free to the end of the event. To wrap up the event we have included a couple of ideas, that utilize games supplied, that will bring the whole group together jumping, cheering, laughing and feeling downright exhilarated.

Most Christmas parties start with a meal and sometimes this can be a little awkward, as guests do not always know each other, so also included is an icebreaker game that will get each table (team) talking, laughing and getting to know one another. This will also enable individuals or teams to let loose for the "Save the Reindeer" games to follow. As a bonus all of the games can be given or raffled off as prizes or simply saved for the next party or event. There is no doubt in our minds that you and your fellow employees or family/friends will remember this party for years to come. They will not be able to wait until the next party!
